


ADDING "QUICKLY"


Adverbs ADD to your knowledge about the action.

Not only can you learn all you need to know about adverbs "quickly," but you can use them instantly because you don't have to do anything before adding them.

Just remember:

- **Adverbs do not** change to match the people doing the action!

● ■ 
Tú corres rápidamente.
You run quickly.

● ■ 
Ellos corren rápidamente.
They run quickly.

We can see that the ● changed the ■, but that the **adverb did not** change from one sentence to the next. We **did not** add an 's' when switching from *tú* to *ellos*. No! **Adverbs** don't change.

... and remember:

- Some **adverbs** are placed *before* the **verb**, others are placed *after*.




Before:

●  ■
Yo siempre estudio.
I always study.

●  ■
Yo nunca estudio.
I never study.

Yo I   *rara vez* rarely  *estudio.* study.

After:

Ella She   *no habla* doesn't talk  *mucho.* much.

Ella She   *habla* talks  *poco.* a little.

ADVERB PROVERBS

No ^R te [■] cortes [■] el pelo ⁺ rápidamente.
Do not yourself you cut the hair quickly.

[■] Cruza ⁺ la calle ⁺ cuidadosamente.
Cross the street carefully.

[■] Abrocha ⁺ el cinturón ⁺ seguramente.
Fasten the seatbelt securely.

Si ⁺ nunca [■] bebes, ⁺ siempre [■] puedes ⁺ [conducir.]
If never you drink, always you can drive.

[●] La gente [■] que no ⁺ escucha ⁺ mucho, [■] aprende ⁺ poco.
Those that not listen a lot, learn little.
