

## Treasure Chest and Treasure Map Script

Start with this sentence:

**En mi cofre de tesoro, yo tengo algo ...** \_\_\_\_\_

In my treasure chest, I have something ... (Name a color. Maybe the class will guess what it is.)

Then *choose one* of these options:

1. \_\_\_\_\_ **es importante para mí porque ...**  
(your object) is important to me because ...
2. **Me gusta** \_\_\_\_\_ **porque ...**  
It's pleasing to me (I like it) because ...
3. **Me encanta** \_\_\_\_\_ **porque ...**  
(I love it) because...

Then put your 1st object to the side and say:

**También tengo algo ...** \_\_\_\_\_

I also have something... (and name another color)

Pull your 2nd object out and go back to your three options above, and chose one.

Then go on to your 3rd object and repeat. You're only saying two sentences per object, and the sentences are almost identical. Just don't make them all the same color and the same reason.

When you're done with your objects, place them back in the treasure chest. Then hold up your map. Here's your general script for the map:

**Yo voy a esconder mi tesoro en la isla** \_\_\_\_\_ **cerca de la ciudad**

\_\_\_\_\_ I'm going to hide my treasure on the island (name your island) near the city of (name a city)

**Yo voy a tomar un autobús/avión/bote a** \_\_\_\_\_.

I'm going to take a bus/plane/boat (pick one) to \_\_\_\_\_ (name another place).

**Entonces yo voy a andar** \_\_\_\_\_ **pasos hacia** \_\_\_\_\_

Then I'm going to walk (insert a number) of steps towards the (pick one: este, oeste, norte, sur)

**Voy a hacer un gran hueco y voy a poner mi tesoro dentro del hueco.**

I'm going to make a big hole and I'm going to put my treasure inside the hole.

**Y voy a poner una equis en el mapa.**

And I'm going to put an X on the map.
